Hand Sanitizer Ground Exception: Non-Bulk Shipments

The U.S. Ground provisions below apply to **new manufacturers and subsequent distributors** of hand sanitizers that are manufactured in accordance with the <u>FDA Guidance</u> for Temporary Compounding of Hand Sanitizers that are ethyl alcohol OR isopropyl alcohol based and have an alcohol content NOT EXCEEDING 80% when transported by highway.
